Dear Parents

We have arranged a super field trip for Hedgehog class to visit Trowbridge Museum on 7<sup>th</sup> February 2018.

**Trip details:**

At the museum, the children will be experiencing four different workshops linked to our topic of Houses and Homes:

1. **Norman Castle:** The children will find out what life was like in a Norman castle, handling replica objects and trying on some costumes.
2. **Tudor House:** The children will be encouraged to talk about how houses were made at this time. They will also look at domestic objects and try on some Tudor hats and clothes.
3. **Victorian Cottage:** This activity will show the children how people lived in Victorian England. They will examine a mock-up of a weaver's cottage, try on some Victorian clothes and look at real and replica objects.
4. **1930's semi-detached house:** This activity focuses on the 1930s and 1940s. The children will find out how people did their laundry and what they did for entertainment. Again, there will be some items of clothing to try on.

At the end of the activities, the children will be having their packed lunch at the museum.

**Transport**

We will be catching the 10.01 train to Trowbridge, from Warminster station, and returning on the 13.28 train from Trowbridge station.

- Children need to arrive at school at the normal time of 8.50am.
- Children are required to wear school uniform, sensible shoes and a coat, as they will be walking to and from the stations.
- Money – we will not be visiting the shop so our children do not need to take any pocket money with them.
- Cost of the trip is £6.21. This cost goes towards the train fare and entrance fee. This contribution is voluntary but it should be noted that if insufficient contributions are received, it may not be possible for the trip to go ahead.
- Please go to the trips section in Wisepay, **by 2<sup>nd</sup> February**, to pay for the trip, confirm your child's packed lunch arrangements and give your consent. If you have any problems accessing Wisepay please speak to the office staff who will be happy to help you.
- The packed lunch provided by our caterers is ham sandwich (main) or cheese sandwich (vegetarian). Also included is a piece of fruit; crisps and a flapjack. The children will need to bring their own drink please.
