

## **Pupil Premium – Service Children**

### **Attainment 2011-2012**

We are mindful that our Service children arrive at different starting points.

Pupil Premium has been used to:

- Provide 1:1 and small group intervention support for pupils with qualified teachers. Mathematics was the key focus with some groups also receiving support in reading and writing.
- Facilitate 1:1 reading work with key Teacher Assistants.
- Facilitate Teacher Assistant support.

### **Attainment outcomes (Service children):**

Reception Class (FS2)                  60% achieved a good level of achievement compared to the 2011 national average (all pupils) of 59%.

When looking at the average expected level:

Yr1 Reading                  91% were in line with the average level and 77% were above.

Yr1 Writing                  82% were in line with the average level and 68% were above.

Yr1 Mathematics              95% were in line with the average level and 72% were above.

Yr2 Reading                  91% were in line with the average level and 77% were above.

Yr2 Writing                  82% were in line with the average level and 68% were above.

Yr2 Mathematics              95% were in line with the average level and 72% were above.

Yr 3 Reading 83% were in line with the average level and 83% were above.  
Yr 3 Writing 75% were in line with the average level and 50% were above.  
Yr 3 Mathematics 92% were in line with the average level and 75% were above.

Yr4 Reading 67% were in line with the average level and 67% were above.  
Yr4 Writing 44% were in line with the average level and 33% were above.  
Yr4 Mathematics 67% were in line with the average level and 55% were above.

Yr5 Reading 100% were in line with the average level and 100% were above.  
Yr5 Writing 62% were in line with the average level and 62% were above.  
Yr 5 Mathematics 100% were in line with the average level and 62% were above.

#### Yr 6: level 4+ and Level 5

(67% of our Yr6 Service children arrived during Yrs 5& 6. 78% arrived across Yrs 4, 5 and 6. 100% arrived during KS2)

Yr6 Reading 100% achieved Level 4+ 78% achieved Level 5  
Yr6 Writing 100% achieved level 4+ 67% achieved level 5  
Yr 6 Mathematics 67% achieved Level 4+ 44% achieved level 5

## **Pupil Premium – Free School Meal Children**

### **Attainment 2011-2012**

Pupil Premium funding has been used to:

- Provide 1:1 and small group intervention support for pupils with qualified teachers. Mathematics was the key focus with some groups also receiving support in reading and writing.

Of the Free school Meal children in our school:

#### **Reading**

- 100% of Free School Meal children are in line with the average level for their year group.

#### **Writing**

- 100% of Free School Meal children are in line with the average level for their year group.

#### **Mathematics**

- 100% of Free School Meal children are in line with the average level for their year group.
- 50% of free School Meal children are above the average level for their year group.
